

THE UNITED STATES ATTORNEY CHARGES THAT:

Beginning on a date unknown but at least as early as April 3, 2012, and continuing until at least April 4, 2016, in the Northern District of Georgia, the defendant, IVAN PONDER, knowingly aided and abetted Elvis Gordon (an officer and employee of the executive branch of the United States Government), who participated personally and substantially as a Government officer and employee, by rendering a decision, approval, recommendation, and otherwise, in an application, contract, claim, charge, and other particular matter in which Elvis Gordon and PONDER had a financial interest.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 208(a) and 216(a)(1)
and Section 2.
