As a result of its review of the ACUS ethics program, the Office of Government Ethics (OGE) issued one recommendation in its November 2024 review report. OGE conducted a follow-up review to assess whether ACUS has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying these recommendations. The results of the follow-up review are summarized below.

1	Provide required employees with annual ethics training each year.	<p>At the time of the November report’s publication, ACUS had not provided any employees with required annual ethics training for nearly two years. OGE acknowledges that ACUS employees did receive some training on a variety of ethics-related topics, however.</p> <p>ACUS was advised to document or certify that required employees received training that met regulatory requirements, and ACUS swiftly fulfilled OGE’s recommendation. Just a month after the report’s publication all ACUS employees who were required to receive annual ethics training had completed the training for calendar year 2024.</p>	Closed
Based on the results of OGE’s follow-up review, the recommendation is closed.
