As a result of its review of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (FERC) ethics program, the Office of Government Ethics (OGE) issued one recommendation in its July 2022 review report. OGE conducted a follow-up review to assess whether FERC has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying this recommendation. The results of the follow-up review are summarized below.

OGE determined that the notice contained the required 5 C.F.R. § 2638.103 text and a copy of the Principles of Ethical Conduct.</p>	Closed
