Dear Ms. Thompson-King:

As a result of its review of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) ethics program, the Office of Government Ethics (OGE) issued two recommendations in its October 2017 review report. OGE recently conducted a follow-up review to assess whether NASA has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying these recommendations. The results of the follow-up review are summarized below.

	Recommendation	Agency Action and OGE Finding	Status
1	Ensure that non-PAS new entrant public financial disclosure reports are filed timely.	OGE examined a sample of non-PAS new entrant public financial disclosure reports and found that 93% were filed timely.	Closed
2	Ensure that confidential financial disclosure reports are filed timely.	OGE examined a sample of confidential financial disclosure reports and found that 87% were filed timely.	Closed
