The United States Office of Government Ethics (OGE) previously conducted a review of the Privacy and Civil Liberties Oversight Board's (PCLOB) ethics program. The December 2014 report summarizing the results of the review included two recommendations. One of the recommendations was closed based on actions taken prior to issuance of the final report. OGE has conducted a follow-up review to assess whether PCLOB has taken action sufficient to resolve the deficiencies underlying the remaining recommendation. As indicated below, this recommendation is now closed based on the action PCLOB has taken.
